



HBO/Cinemax DigiCipher II IRD Ordering Information

A Motorola/GI DigiCipher II IRD or MD Receiver is required to receive HBO/Cinemax programming.

These are some of the current available models;

DSR-4410MD Satellite Multiplex Decrypter (DCII and DVB S-2)
DSR-4410 Commercial Satellite Receiver (DCII)
DSR-4530 Commercial IRD(DCII)
DSR-4550 Commercial IRD (DCII)
DSR-6050 Commercial Receiver-Transcoder (DVB S-2, MPEG-4 HD > MPEG 2 HD)
DSR-6300 Multi-Channel Commercial IRD/Transcoder (DVB S-2, MPEG-4 HD > MPEG 2 HD)

*Cinemax HD (MPEG-2) requires a MegaPipe+ (MPP) capable receiver such as the DSR-4410MD, DSR-4410, DSR-4530 or DSR-4550.

**MPEG-4 HD channels require a DSR-4410MD, DSR-6050 or a DSR-6300 only.

NOTE re the DSR-6300 IRD: HBO does not support the HD>SD down-conversion functionality of the DSR-6300. Three MPEG-2 HD programs are available at the IRD output.

***New launches of HBO On Demand (HOD) and Cinemax on Demand (MaxOD) do not require an IRD, as the DVB S-2 satellite receiver is integrated into the Ericsson Next Generation NG-CAT-HBO catcher.
